

# Teacher's Training Program At Mohammad Pur (Sohna Dhani Village) on 16<sup>th</sup> October, 2017

The Workshop was held at Government School at MohammadPur (SohnaDhani Village). The village has an approximate population of 3000. Principal Sir BanvoadriLalKaushill, helped organize the workshop. It was attended by 7male teachers of Govt. Middle School as well as Govt. Primary School along with approximately 205 students of primary and middle school Conducted by Counsellor: Ms.S.Priyanka and IshaGarg.

## Sessions were interactive and the topics discussed were-

1. Helping teachers to understand key adolescent issues like behavioural problems, substance abuse, etc and the importance of Classroom Management
2. How expressed behaviors of children can aid identification of problematic behavior
3. Dealing sensitively with relationship issues amongst adolescence.
4. Identification of developmental disorders and learning disabilities
5. Since parents are oblivious to the education of the children, current situation of that the teachers. And how they can psycho-educate the children



## Methodology used-

1. Audio visual presentation on key childhood and adolescent development, developmental disorders and learning disabilities
2. Brain storming on how to involve parents in process of child education and development.

## Learning outcomes and the road ahead-

1. The major concern faced by the school is that there is not even a single female teacher to help and understand the queries of the girls studying in the school.
2. The principal of the school is well aware about the sensitivity of this topic and has himself heard cases regarding child sexual abuse. This village has more number of NHR (Non Haryana Resident) and the children running away with their partners has commonly been witnessed.
3. The principal shared with us many interesting stories and techniques which he uses to educate and guide the students. The methods and the morals shared by the principal enlightened us aswell.
4. The video on child sexual abuse was informative and the teachers requested to be provided by such easy to understand and explain audio visuals and books for the children.
5. The school is not able to conduct ' BalikaManch' due to lack of female faculty.
6. There is a DTH facility provided by the Haryana Government for the students but the channel shows repeated episodes and thus the purpose is not being served.
