6. Role of teachers as a Counselor and facilitator.
7. Various ways to identify the learning in children.
8. Including learning disabilities students in classroom.

Learning outcomes and the road ahead-

1. Detailed information about adolescence issues.
2. Focus also needs to come on psycho-social education of parents since issues of child marriage are still prevalent and reduce the rate of girl child drop out.
3. Interventions through clinical assessment and follow up can lead to a successful diagnosis.
4. Psychosocial and emotional wellbeing of the care givers along with the child is very important for better, progressive and enhanced facilitation of children.
5. Understanding of learning disabilities and its identification in neurological causes.
6. Identifying students with learning disabilities and referring them for further assessment and intervention.
